Looking back...

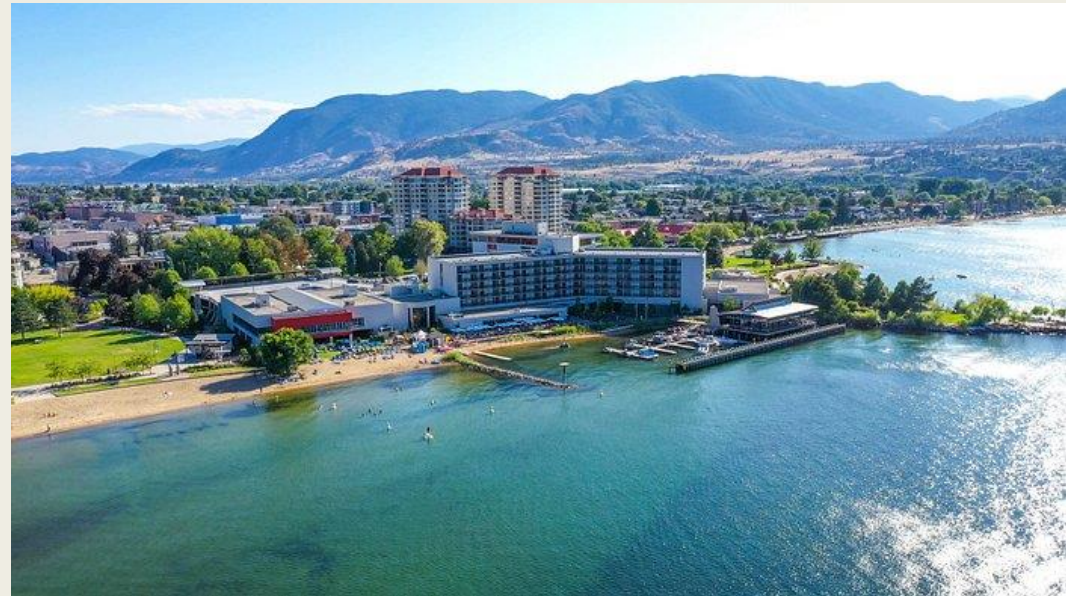
- Founded in 1971 as B.C. Water Well Drillers Association
- Work with Ministry to create the first BC Well Record form (1972)
- Acted as a 'go-between' between industry and government
- Promote Best Practices to Industry and Gov't
 - *Pitless adaptors, 4" submersible pumps, water sampling, surface seals, well tags, flowing well seals, sounding tubes...*
- Drilling Rates Survey (1996)*
- Spearheaded the Well Owner Workshops (WOW) in 2011(?)
- After the collapse of the CGWA, created a made in BC driller/pump installer certification program through the ITA
- Work with Ministry to produce electronic well mapping for well locations and logs (GWells)
- BC Groundwater Protection Regulations Handbook including best practices
- Created scholarship opportunities for aspiring new drillers and grad students (e.g. Laurie Desilets Memorial Scholarship and BCGWA Graduate Award in Hydrogeology)
