COMMERCIAL VEHICLE SAFETY & ENFORCEMENT



- Provincial Peace Officer Status
- Authorized to enforce 6 Acts and their Regulations (MVA/R CTA/R)
- We do not enforce Criminal Code Violations
- Enforce moving violations including speeding
- Priority is for vehicles over 5,500kgs



- Responsible for CVIP/PVIP Designated Inspection Facilities
- School bus permits and inspections
(Each bus annually)
- Post crash fatal investigations
- Carrier Audits to NSC standards
- Chain up enforcement



- Part of CVSA (Commercial Vehicle Safety Alliance)
- Roadside Inspections
- All inspectors are CVSA certified
- Inspection is the same as a pre-trip, no mechanics qualification needed
- Out of service conditions set by CVSA. North American wide (including Cuba)



Thompson Nicola District

- Large area which includes Clearwater, Barriere, Kamloops, Merritt, Lytton, Spences Bridge, Savona, and approx 38 kms north of Hope
- 20 staff and 10 vehicles including 3 unmarked vehicles.
- 2 Inspection stations (scales) located on Hwy 1 in Kamloops



Things CVSE are not responsible for:

- Enacting chain up lights
- Enacting load restrictions
- Exempting carriers from load restrictions
- Road maintenance
- Speed limit changes
