- Not about reserve funds

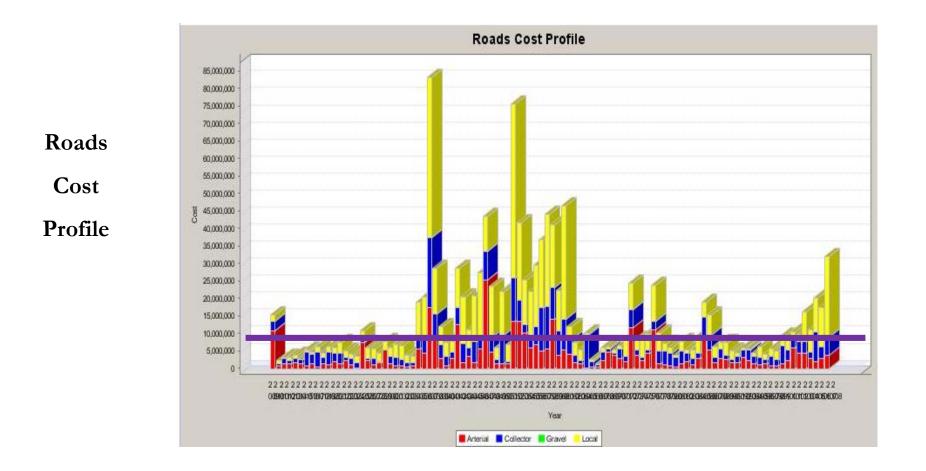
"An asset without a user has no value"

Communications

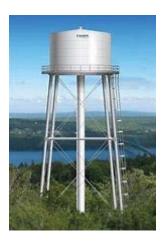
- Our biggest issue because of audience

- Why are people not getting it?

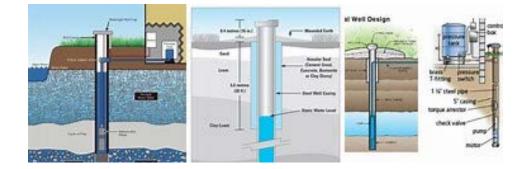


Summary
